

## Buffett Beach Blast Tailgate Party Policies

**For your safety and enjoyment of the Buffett Beach Blast evening presented by the Salisbury Beach Partnership, Inc. and hosted by the owners of Carefree Parking, PLEASE READ and FOLLOW the policies outlined below.**

### ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION

- Consumption of alcohol in the parking lot shall be permitted during tail gate party hours only from 6-8PM. No consumption of alcohol shall be allowed during or after the show.
- Open containers of alcohol are prohibited on the streets of Salisbury and could result in arrests and court action. No open containers may leave the Carefree Parking Lot.
- Consumption of alcohol is not permitted in the adjacent Blue Ocean Event Center Parking Lot.
- Massachusetts state law makes it illegal for anyone under age 21 to purchase, arrange to have purchased, transport, possess, consume, or carry alcoholic beverages.
- The promoter reserves the right to ID all participants at any time during the party. Anyone under the legal age transporting, possessing, or consuming alcohol shall have all alcohol in their possession confiscated and shall be asked to leave.
- Regardless of age, the unlawful use of alcohol, drunk and disorderly conduct (including assault and battery and property damage), and violation of any policies listed here may result in confiscation of alcohol, being asked to leave the premises, and lack of admittance to the show.
- No shots of any kind, including Jello shots, are to be consumed or shared with others while on the premises.
- For your own protection, please make sure you have a designated driver or use a transportation service.

### FOOD, GRILLING AND TRASH REMOVAL

- Participants should eat appropriate amounts of food in relationship to drink and have plenty of non-alcoholic beverages available.
- Leave no trace – you must remove all of your own trash, including used charcoal.

### RESTROOMS

- Please use restroom facilities in the lobby of the Blue Ocean Event Center building.
